The exclusive "Fibre4" all fiberglass stringer system is built into every Sea Fox boat, providing a wider, stronger stringer that will not rot! In addition to a stronger platform, decks are fiberglassed to the broad stringer tops resulting in a superior bond between hull, stringers and deck.

Sea Fox boats are constructed using an all composite core material that is lighter and more durable than wood. It will not rot!

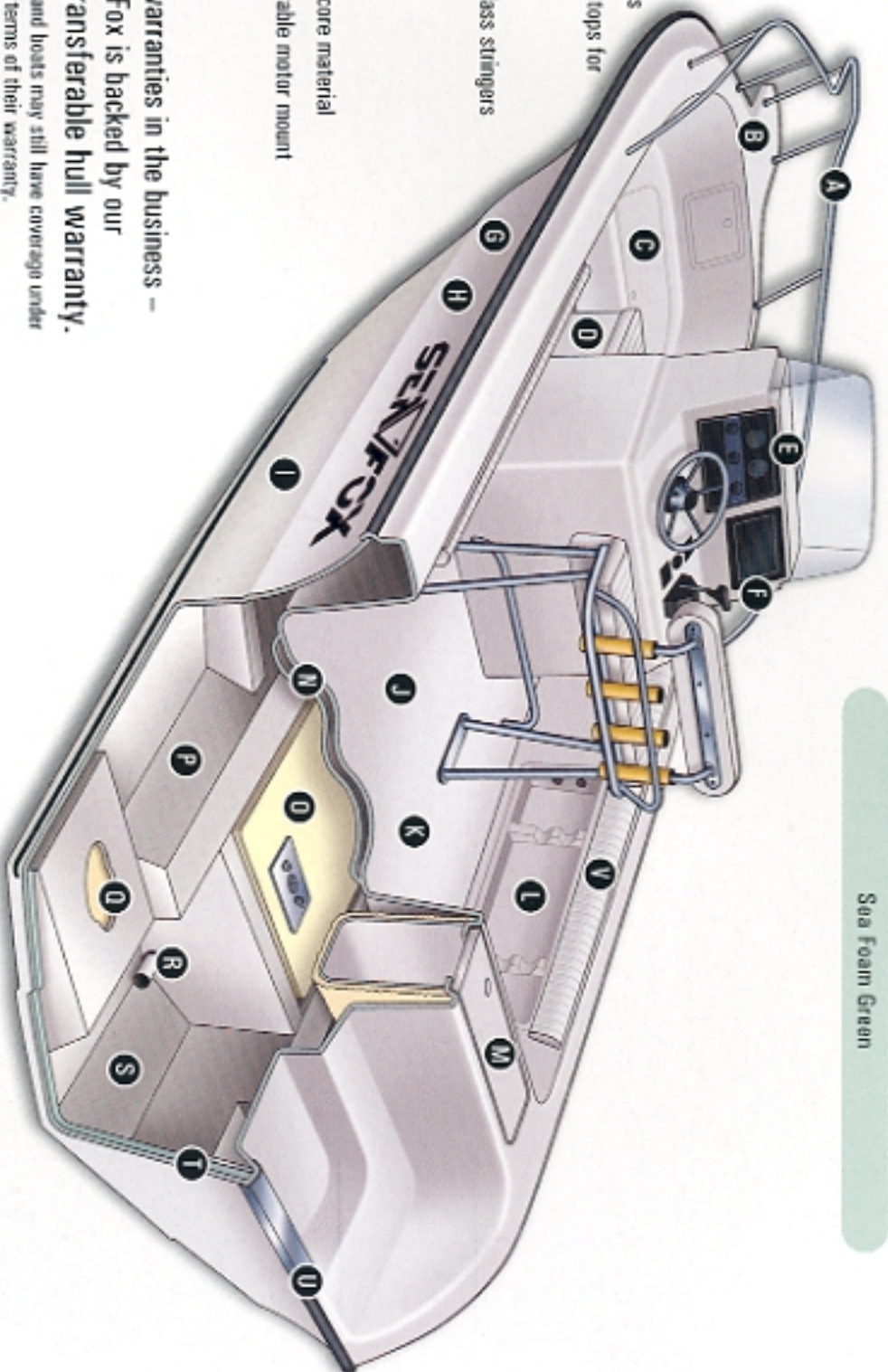
An aluminum plate is glassed into the hull providing a backing for motor mounts.

Composite core materials provide strength in floors, consoles and hatch lids. No wood, no rot!

Facts That Keep Sea Fox Out Front

- Fibre4 Stringer System – Fiberglass stringers are wider than wooden ones and will not rot when exposed to water.
- A high density foam core hull will not deteriorate as wood does when exposed to water, plus the aluminum plate within the transom provides extra engine mounting strength.
- Hand-rolled fiberglass means fewer air pockets plus a superior laminate.
- Self-bailing cockpits allow water to drain overboard.
- Non-skid deck surfaces aid in safer deck surfaces.
- Stainless steel hardware eliminates the worry of saltwater corrosion.
- Closed cell foam flotation – foam injected into key areas of the hull and deck provide superior flotation and insulation.
- Family-owned with more than 47 years experience – a proud heritage of experience that goes into each boat built.
